The McKenzie River area offers boundless recreation opportunities, with rivers, streams, lakes and mountain views. Trout and Steelhead fishing on the McKenzie river ranks among the world's finest. Fishing guides, scenic river guides and white water raft trips can easily be arranged. A wide variety of hiking trails, lakes, reservoirs and golf courses are just minutes away. Our location also features nearby cafés, restaurants, cocktail bars, food markets, laundry facilities, liquor stores, post offices, and ranger stations. Whatever you are looking for, you are sure to find it here.

Spring, Summer & Fall

- Fishing: Drop a line in from your own private deck, or explore the many near by lakes and reservoirs. You can catch rainbow or cutthroat trout, summer steelhead, and chinook salmon.
- Boating and canoeing: Enjoy the water at any of the near by lakes, such as Clear Lake.
- White Water Rafting: Guided trips are available for a half or full day — a great way to beat the heat in the summer!
- Biking: McKenzie River Trail offers 27-miles of spectacular scenery, including waterfalls and old growth forests.
- Nature Sight-Seeing: Explore our volcanic peaks, lava beds, and waterfalls (like Sahalie, Koosah and Proxy Falls). Drive the Aufderheide Scenic Byway to experience some of the most breathtaking scenery in Oregon.
- Hiking or nature walks: The Willamette National Forest, McKenzie River corridor, and the McKenzie Pass area are full of diverse trails.
- Golf: Tokatee Golf Club, one of the country's highest rated public courses, or McKenzie River Golf Course, a 9 hole public course bordering the McKenzie River are both near by.

Winter

- Relax indoors: Enjoy a cozy fire and listen to the powerful McKenzie River just outside your back door.
- Hot Springs: Belnap hot springs offers a relaxing soak.
- Fishing: Fishing in the McKenzie area is outstanding year round.
- Shopping and Dining: Try local restaurants in Vida, or take the short drive east to the Western yet upscale town of Sisters.
- Hiking and Biking: The local trails are open year-round
- Ski and Snowboard: Play in the snow at Hoodoo Ski Bowl, and explore the many cross country and snowshoeing trails.

COTTAGE FEATURES

Built in the early 1940's, our cottages have a grace and charm reminiscent of a more gentle era. While we have maintained the "rustic" touches of that time, we have also incorporated some modern conveniences. We have four cottages in two styles—studio and one bedroom. The studio cottages have a queen size bed in the living area. The one bedroom cottages have a king size bed and a queen sleeper sofa. French doors open from the living room onto spacious decks directly over the water. The cottages each have a full size bathroom (tub and shower), a charcoal grill, a fully equipped kitchen, a fireplace and central heat. Linens, dishes and towels are also provided. Units are non-smoking, no pets allowed.

We invite you to relax and refresh in the cool, green Willamette National Forest even throw in your fishing line. If you keep a sharp eye out, you may even see Osprey and Blue Herons building their nests in the surrounding tree tops.

RENTAL RATES

One Bedroom Cottage:

Sleeps 2 to 4 people — \$120 + tax/night

Please let us know if you need additional sleeping accommodations and we can arrange a roll-away twin bed for you.

Studio Cottage:

Sleeps 1-2 people — \$105 + tax/night

Weekly Rate: Pay for 6 nights, get the 7th night free!

Rates are based on double occupancy—add \$10/night for each additional person. Check in is 3pm, check out is 11am. **CANCELLATION POLICY:** 30-day cancellation notice is required May through September. 14-day cancellation notice October through April. If cancellation notice is given prior to these deadlines a full refund will be made, minus a 10% processing fee. If cancellation doesn't meet the deadline, the party will be responsible for the entire dates of the reservation. We will make every effort to re-rent the cottage, and if we do a full refund minus the 10% process fee will apply.

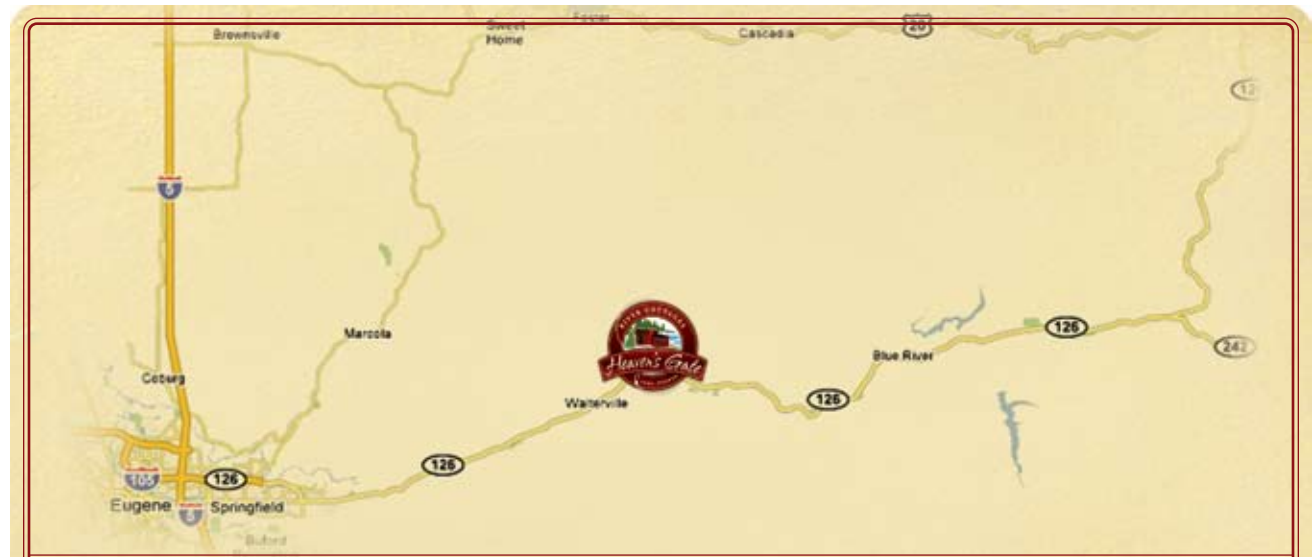
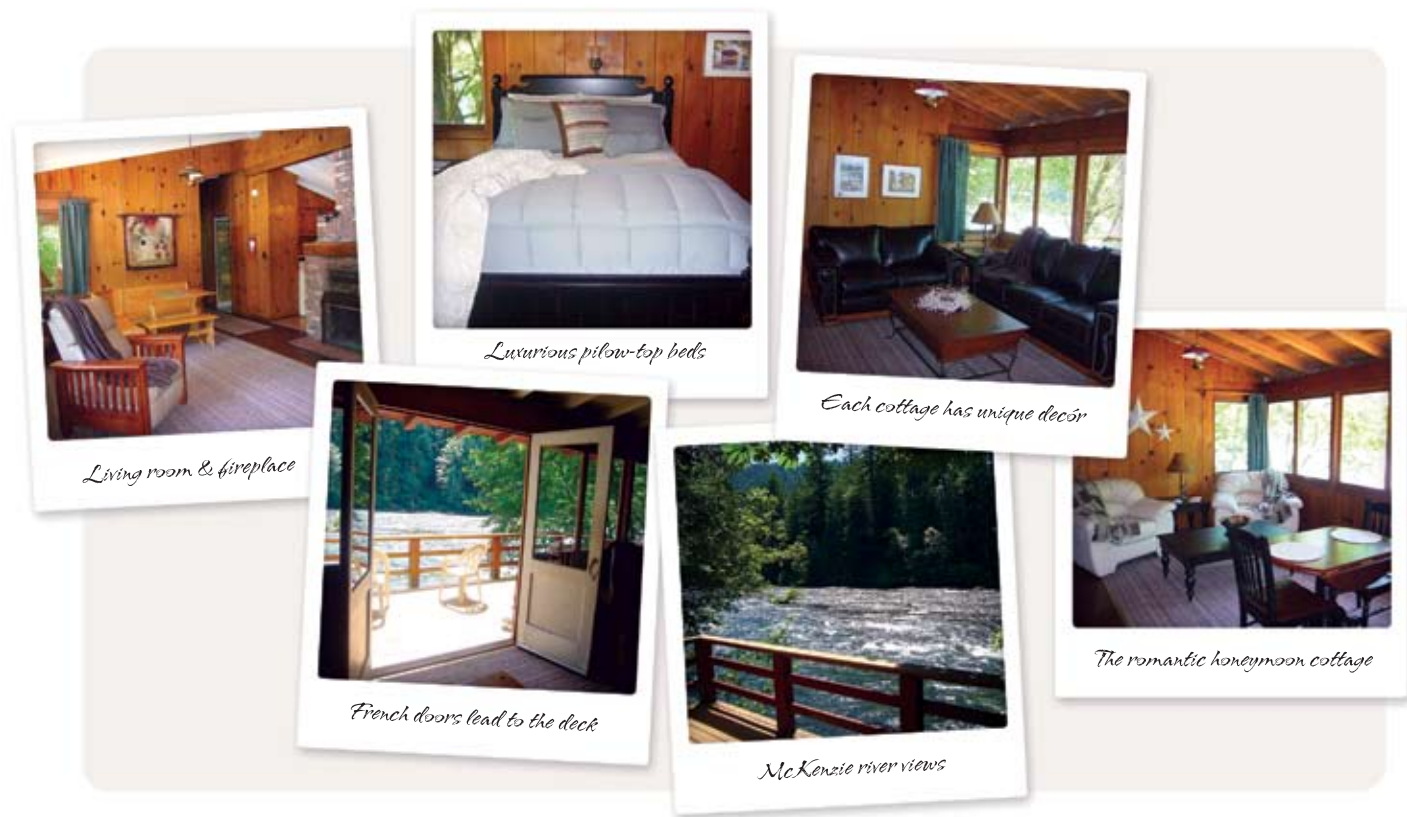

Heaven's Gate River Cottages are located in Vida, Oregon—picturesquely nestled along the shore of the McKenzie River. **From Portland:** Drive south on I-5, then take Highway 126 towards Bend.

From Eugene/Springfield: Take Highway 126, (McKenzie River Highway) to Vida, Oregon — we are located at milepost 36 1/2. If you reach the town of Blue River, you have gone about 4 miles too far.
